

COVID-19 Response – Medium to Long Term

Medium to Longer Term Change Management

- Gifts: has accelerated and catapulted school principals comfort and acceptance of technology
- Raised broader social awareness of the issues confronting marginalized communities, alongside elevated compassion
- Increased awareness of the need to technological access
- Practical exercise in change and crisis management which is a core tenet of PfP
- Ability to extend support to partners and cement commitment through crisis

Preparing for the Future

- Prepare for possible need to launch and manage upcoming circles virtually
- Positioning the increased need for support of school principals, given the unprecedented levels of complexity they will be facing upon re-opening of schools
- Mobilising and motivating for increased funding for and practical support of these partnerships
