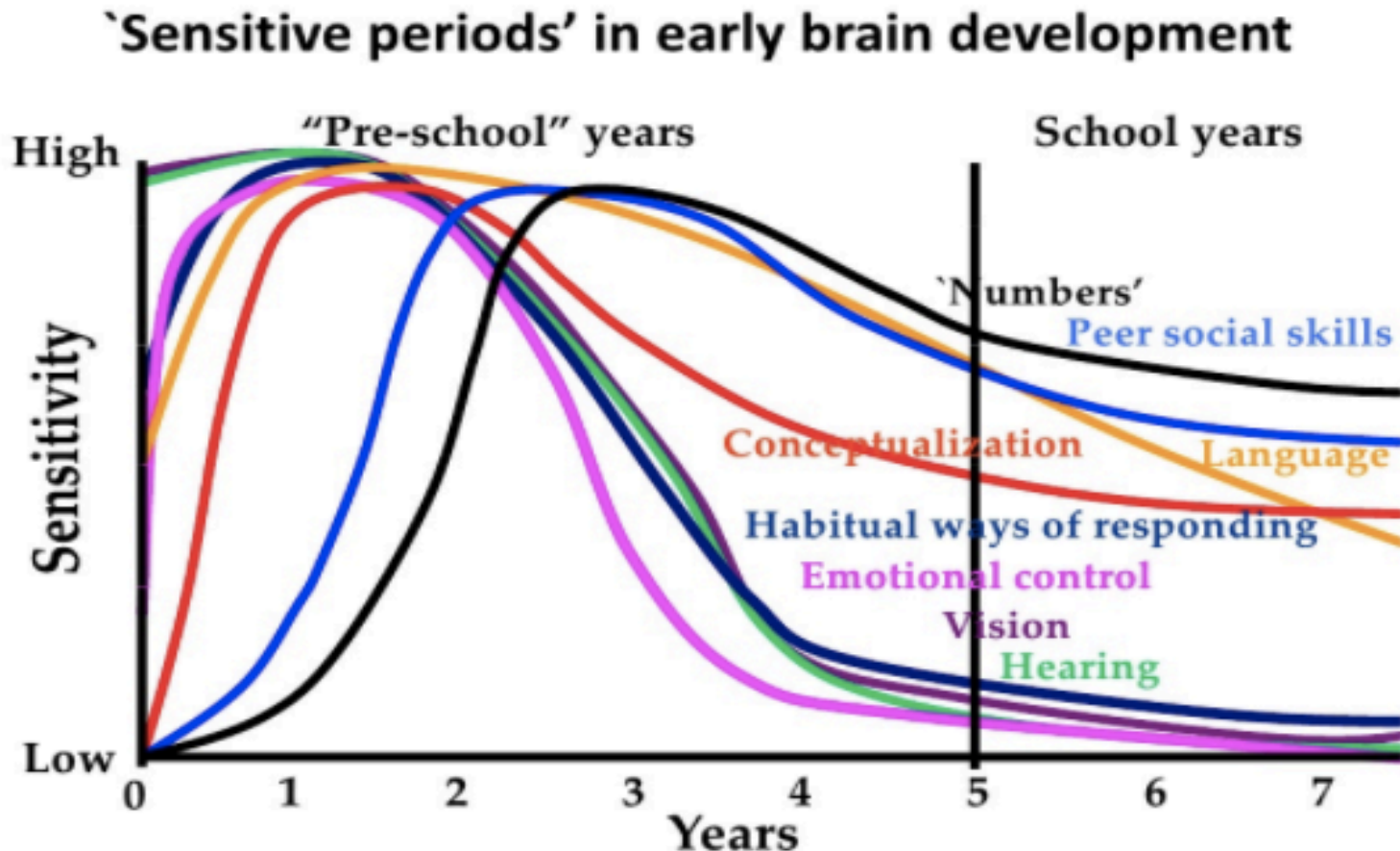

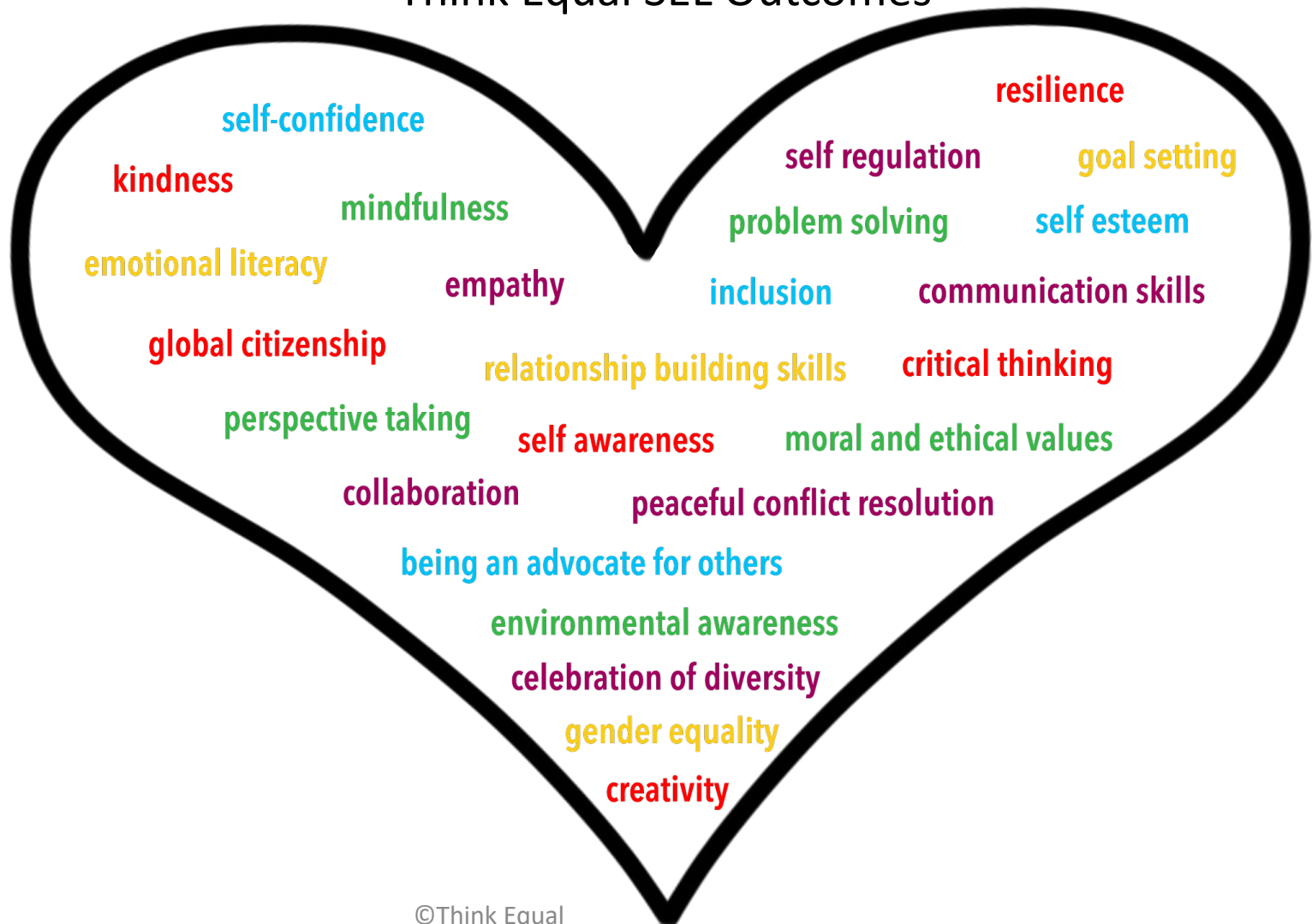
The Importance of Early Learning

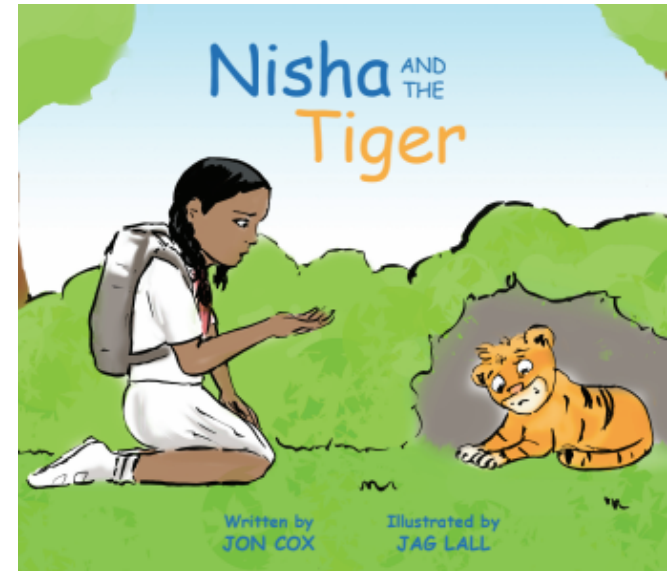
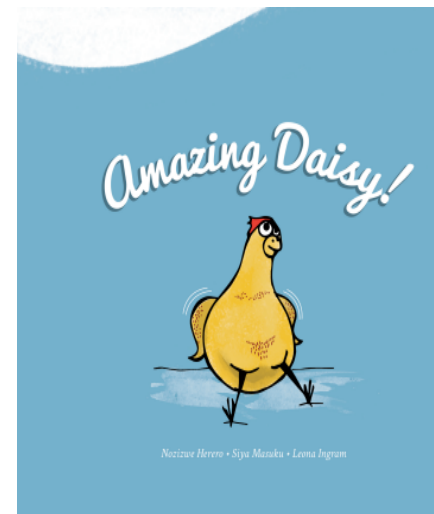
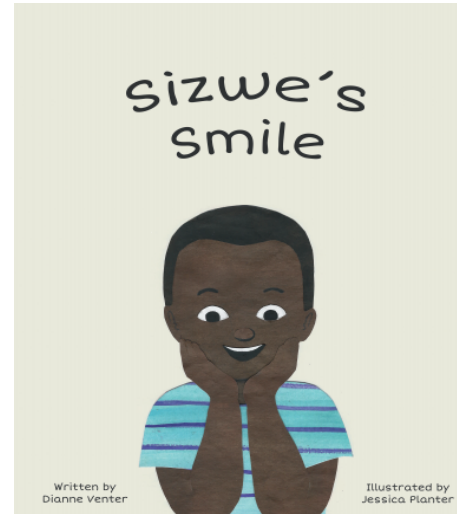
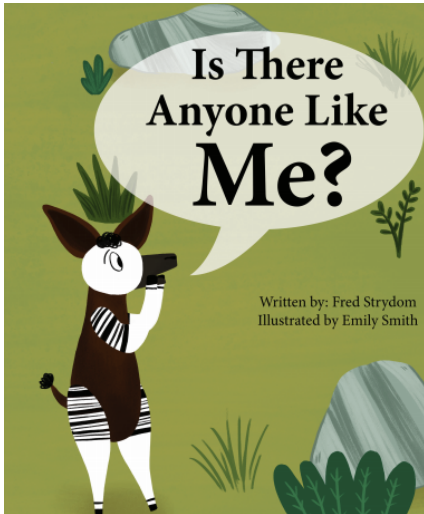
Lesson Plans



The programme design:

- 30 weeks of term time
- 3 lessons per week
- 30 minute lesson plans
- 1.5 hours of teaching per week
 - $30 \times 1.5 = 45$ hours of guided SEL per year.

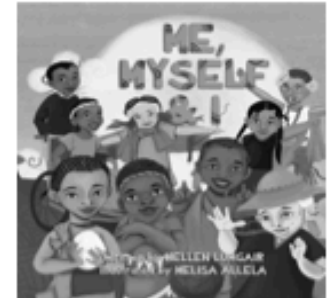

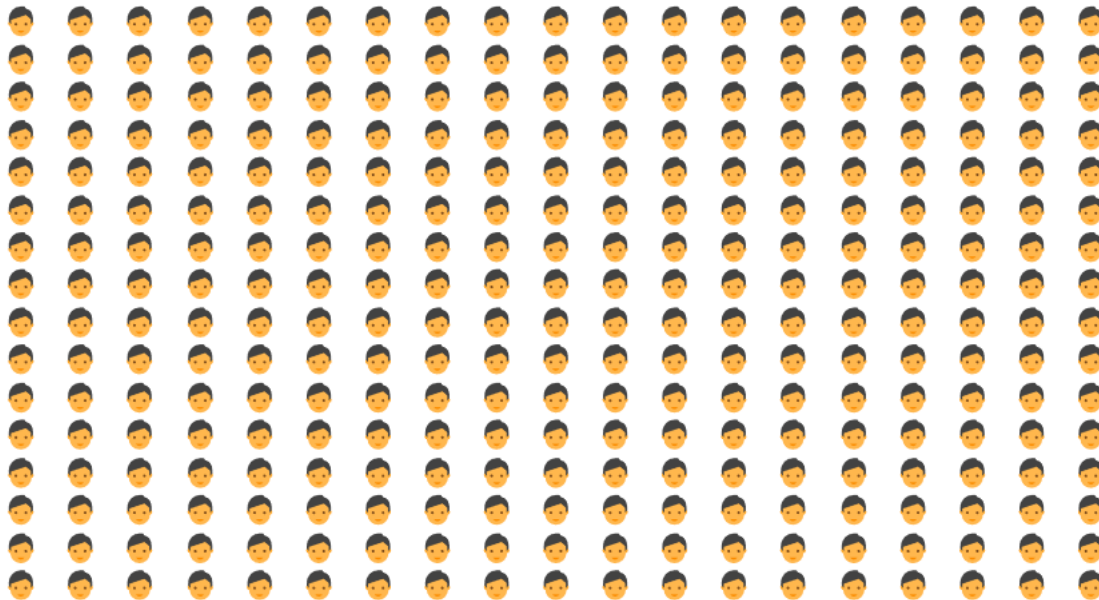
